A Court Term

The recovery of goods, wrongfully taken, or detained, held up. To recover possession of, by an action of law or writ by which things are replevined. Any cost, interest, damages, or losses incurred must be paid in full.

This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith Yahuah, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; 17) and their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.

Heb.6:17-18

Wherein Yahuah, willing more abundantly to show unto the heirs of promise the immutability of his counsel, confirmed it by an oath: 18) That **by two immutable things**, in which it was impossible for Yahuah to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us:

- **Yahuah made a covenant with us**
- **Yahuah puts his Laws, in our heart & mind**

Two Immutable Things:

- **Yahuah will not break a promise or an oath**
 - **Yahuah can not lie**

Covenants are empowered by a covenant that's operating on the inside of me: and independent of anybody or anything else. **Promises** receive strength from a promise that's operating on the inside of my life; and my obedience to it, is independent of everything else.
